


Finding your kWh consumption on the Rocky Mountain Power portal

STEP 1 - LOGIN

- Go to the Rocky Mountain Power login page at: <https://csapps.rockymountainpower.net/idm/my-account>
- Log in to your account with your Email/User ID and password.



- If you haven't visited the online portal yet, you may need to register and create your credentials.*

STEP 2 - SELECT ENERGY USAGE
